Initiative: The Educational Living Center's goal is to empower residents through a three year immersive experience, fostering academic, practical, and social skills for professional development.

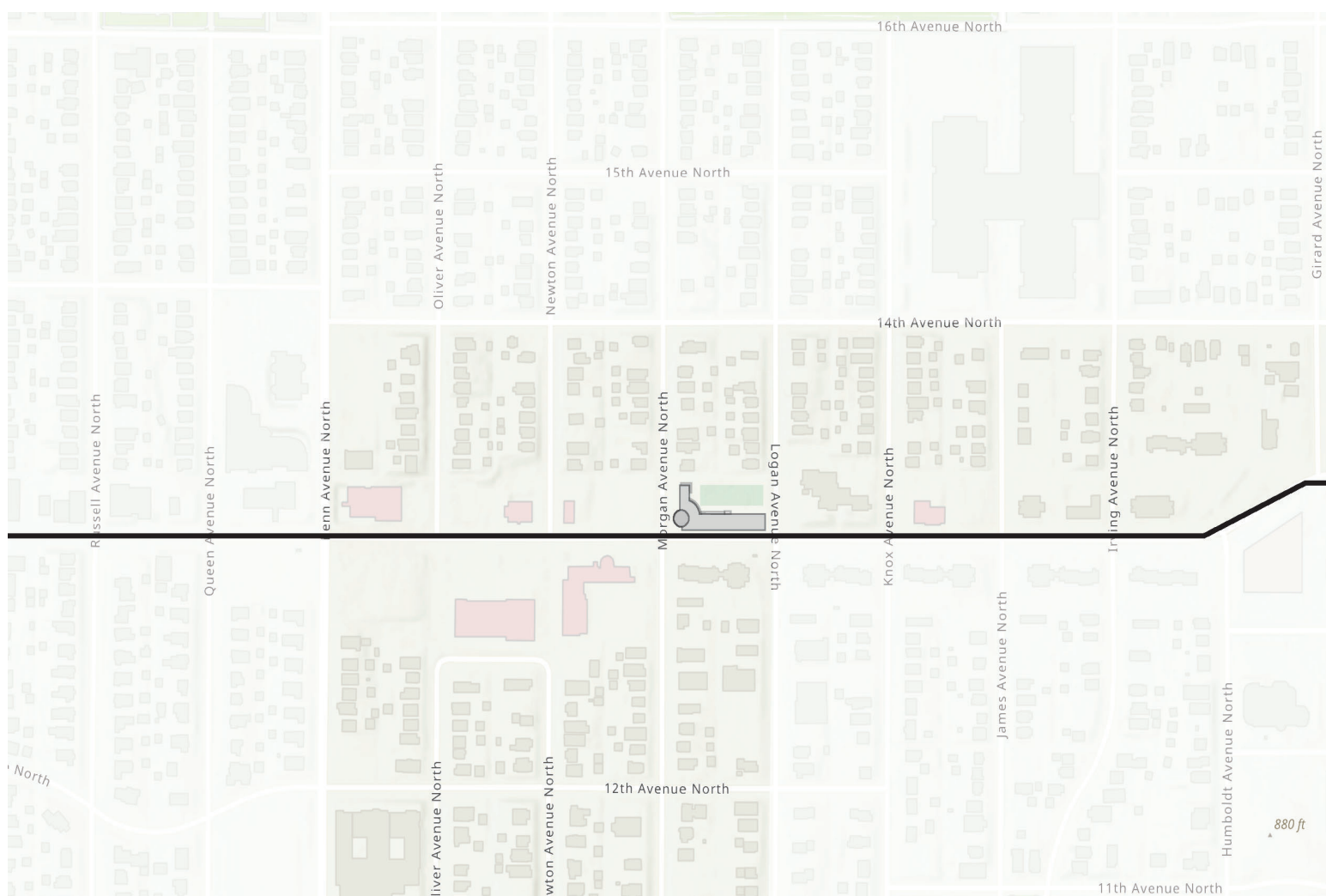
Location: Plymouth Ave N. and Morgan Ave N

PROJECT GOALS

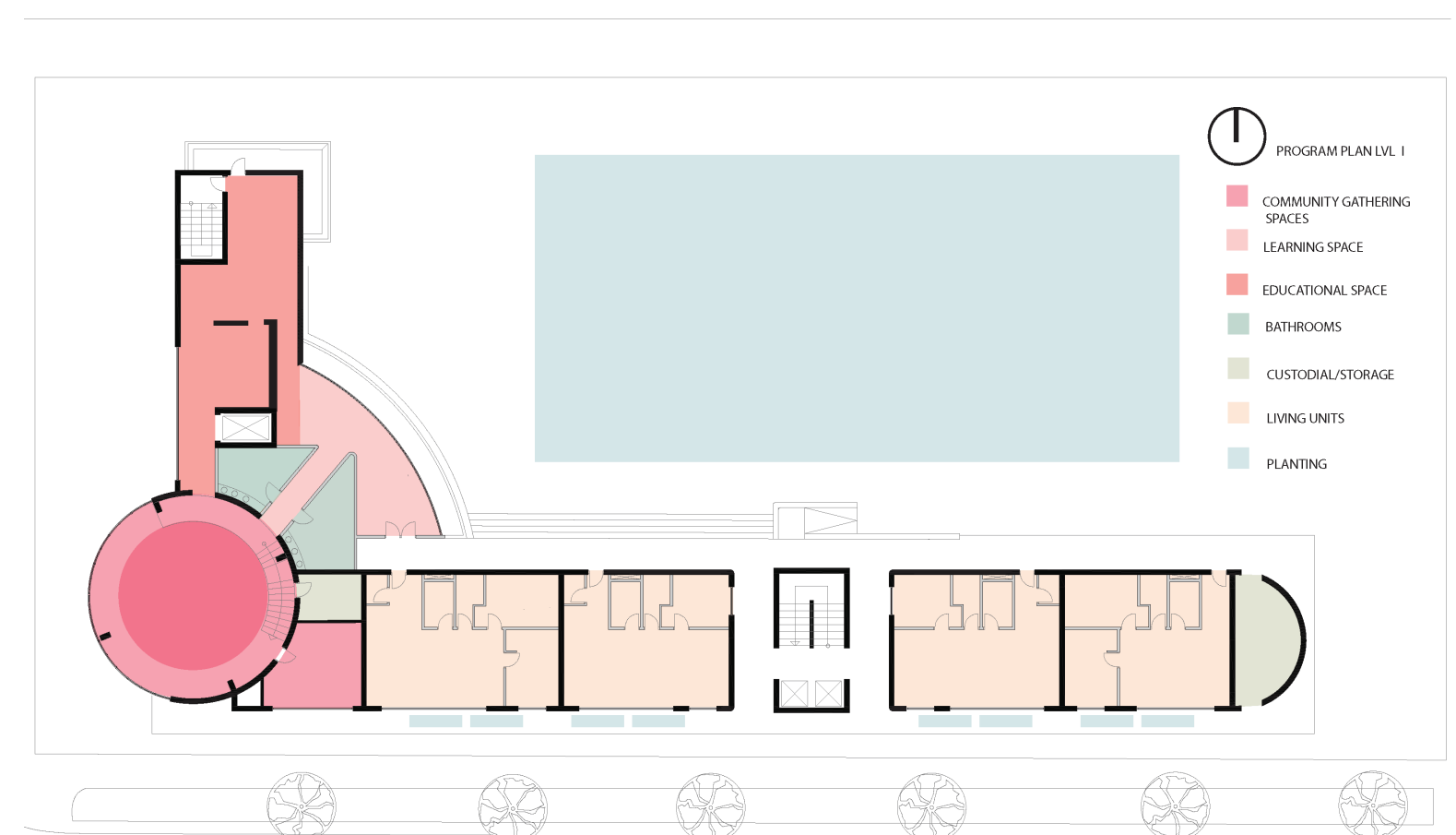

multifaceted engagement serves as a cornerstone for personal growth and community integration within the Educational Living Center.

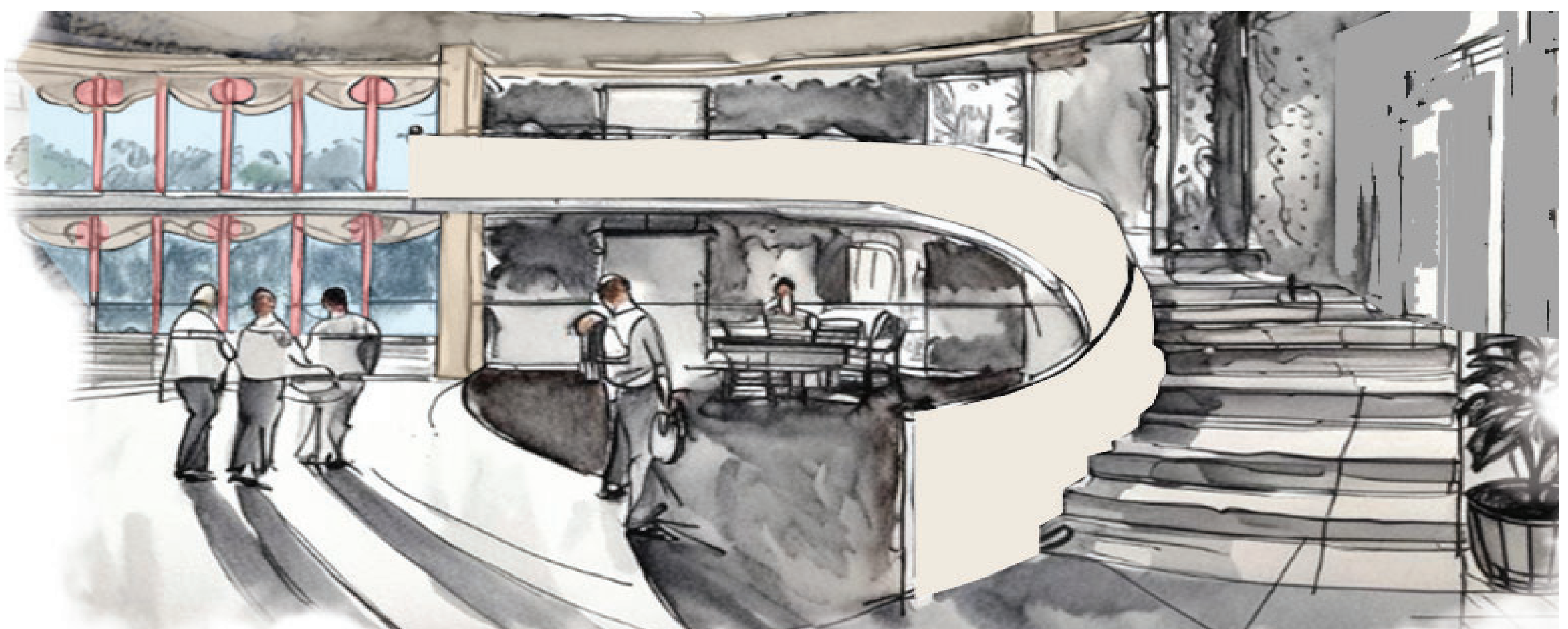
