

PROGRAM TYPES

UNIT A: Social Hub Year 1

Used for first year participants. This 2 bedroom unit has a shared living space to foster belonging and connections among residents. The d.i.y. and educaitonal space encourages students to learn from community experts. Additionally, the common areas act doubly as a skill workshop and a gathering area for participants to socialize and learn together.



2 BEDROOM LAYOUT




VIEW OF 2 BEDROOM LIVING AREA

As residents graduate/they will have local community based avenues to work and professional apply the skills they've learned.




1 BEDROOM LAYOUT
